### Program Objectives

- To prepare 3 to 5 year-old children for formal schooling
- To work on the foundational literacy, numeracy and reading skills of 6 to 14 year old children
- Mainstream children in public education system
- Empower parents and community members towards continued education of the children
- Spread awareness to the youths of the community for Vocational skills and career opportunities

*A variety of teaching aids, reading materials, language-based games, and newspaper reading sessions are utilized as pedagogical tools while instructing the children.*

*Additionally, educational field trips were organized for the children to places such as the local Police Station, a Medical Center, and a Maha E-Seva Center*

*Sima Pradhan getting the Award from  
Lalith Singla and Anju Singla*

*We have a highly deserving girl student, Sima Pradhan, who has secured 88% marks in PCM in 12th board exams. She has been able to secure admission in the 4-year B. Tech in CSE with AI/ML course at the IILM University, Gurgaon.*

*Chance India has awarded her a scholarship of INR 25,000 (twenty-five thousand only) over the next 4 years, making it a cumulative scholarship support of INR 1,00,000 (one lakh) for her college fee.*

*Sima comes from a very poor family. Her father works as a pantry boy and cannot afford to pay for her college fees. The university has offered her a 30% scholarship. There are other NGOs and corporates who are supporting her. Her parents are also stretching to pay for part of the cost.*

*Seema has chosen this program due to her passion for technology & programming, desire to solve real world problems, high market demand and future growth potential.*

*Chance's support can be life-changing for Sima and her family. This can help Sima achieve her dreams and break the cycle of poverty for her family.*
